ISKCON NA Child Protection Office Annual Checklist for Management

Having these 12 items in place means that your temple/center/school/project is compliant with ISKCON child protection policies:

It is ISKCON policy that all temples, schools and projects must **have trained and active Child Protection Volunteers**, at least 2-3 devotees. Very small centers may have a child protection point person. The CPVs should receive at minimum the full 6 hour training from the ISKCON CPO to be confirmed CPVs, along with continuing education each year.

4) Implement a policy that 'All children must be supervised by a designated adult at all times while on ISKCON property'.

Complete background checks on all Residents, Staff and Volunteers who serve in a position of trust. This includes:

- 5) Performing Criminal Background Checks for Residents
- 6) CPO Clearance for Residents
- 7) Calling References for Residents
- 8) Criminal Background Check for Staff/Volunteers
- 9) CPO Clearance for Staff/Volunteers
- 10) Calling References for Staff/Volunteers
- 11) **Uphold CPO Case Decisions** When someone has been found responsible for child abuse, requirements and restrictions are placed upon their relationship with ISKCON. It is the position of the local management to uphold the CPO case decision and/or ISKCON policy for those found guilty in court.
- 12) Local Management, Staff, Volunteers in positions of trust/authority, Residents, Teachers and CPVs attend **child abuse awareness training each year** open to adult community members.

Each year arrange abuse prevention training for children in Sunday school/ day school. If neither exist and there are children attending the programs, arrange a stand alone personal safety training for them.
